


Eastwood Nursery Newsletter

The children made their very own paper dolls using paper technology which enabled them to gain a deeper grasp of the story plot enabling them to build their literary skills.






The block play creations developed children's mathematical and scientific knowledge as they explore balance, symmetry, shape and space.

Our Classes


Maple Class

The children have the opportunity to explore Developmental Movement Play through scarves and ribbons.



The DMP involves giving children the freedom to move their bodies in lots of different ways which have a very powerful impact on their brain development. Children need great body

awareness in order to develop skilled and confident movement and a strong sense of self.



We have been learning the numbers through reading the book **Ten Little Fingers and Ten Little Toes** and through the nursery rhymes like **Five little monkeys**

Chestnut Class

We've had an exciting term exploring our <u>mark making skills</u> using different mediums. We are focussing on developing our pencil grip and being able to use different tools to create lines, shapes and pictures.

We have also been developing our <u>fine motor skills</u> through construction activities with the Duplo, completing Mr Potato Heads and puzzles as well as practising our scissor skills.

Outside we are being more adventurous with our <u>gross motor skills</u> through balancing and climbing.
