## **Group Games..**





The children have been turn taking whilst playing small group games. They have particularly enjoyed the game of *pop up pirate* becoming very excited when the pirate pops out of the top of the barrel.

## **Making Shakers..**

The children were very busy posting spaghetti into containers to turn these into shakers whilst singing some of their favourite nursery rhymes.

The older children also explored different sizes when breaking the spaghetti into smaller pieces.



## Puzzles..



The children have been investigating with puzzle pieces, pictures and locks. They have spent a long period of time working out how things work and placing puzzle pieces back into the correct slots.

## All kinds of construction..









The children have been showing a huge interest in planning, designing and constructing with different types of construction resources in Beech Class.

They have been working together collaboratively to make the tallest towers. The children have tested out their ideas placing blocks in different positions to make their structures strong.

Patterns..





The children have been following sequences and patterns working out what shape or colour they needed next to complete their sequence.

This has supported in developing the children's early mathematical skills as they also counted out how many shapes were in their patterns with 1 to 1 correspondence.

## **Making Dens..**





The children made their very own dens with crates, beds, cushions and blankets.

They took it in turns with one another to pretend to read different stories in their dens and were also very excited to turn of the lights and make the classroom dark.
