The children have been experimenting with textures and surfaces and painted and walked across bubble wrap

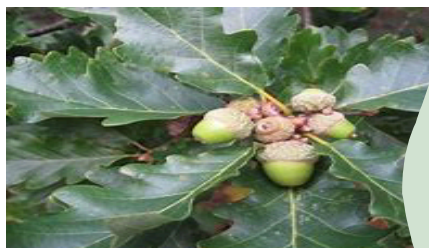
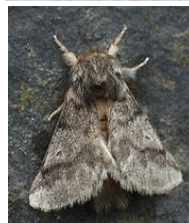
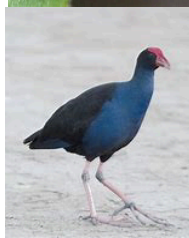
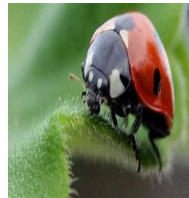


They have been getting messy and creative with mixing different resources

the tomatoes, herbs, strawberries and other plants. The children used watering jugs to water all the plants.

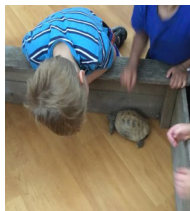
CEDAR CLASS

They have playing timed games such as cone drop and Pom Pom pick up where they have been racing against the clock, and against each other to complete challenges.

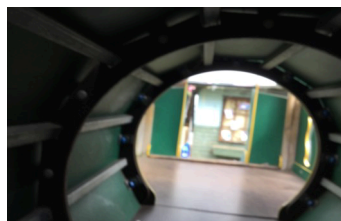
And of course they have spent a lot of time in the water trying to stay cool during the heatwave.
