CLASS

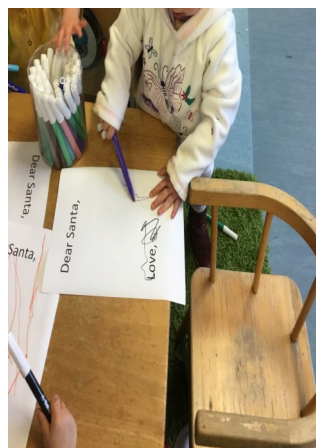
