Feeding the Dolls...

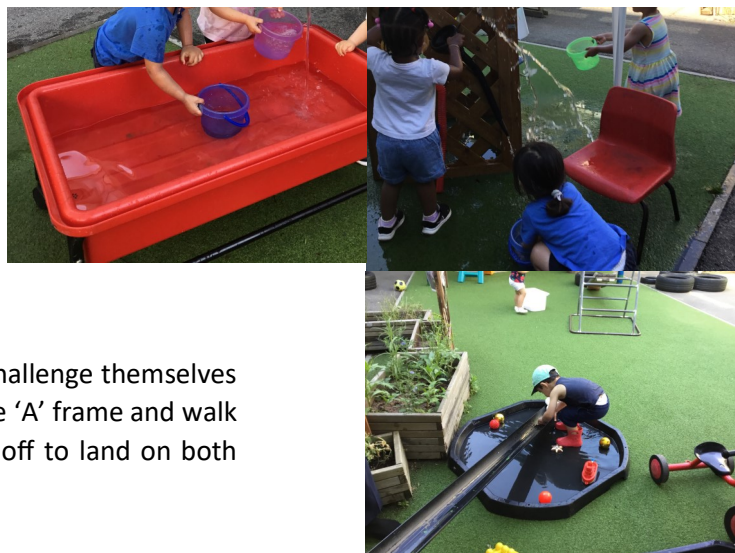


"My baby is hungry".
