The children have been showing an interest in finding their eyes, nose, ears and mouth and have been looking in mirrors at the same time as doing this.


Some of the children have also been copying actions while looking at themselves on the IPad using the camera.







Brown Bear, Brown Bear...



The children have been reading 'Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What do you see?

They have been learning about lots of different animal names and sounds and pointing these out as they find the corresponding illustration.



Beech Class



Eastwood's Pizzeria



In Beech Class the children continued with their interest in imaginative play. Their restaurant then became an Eastwood Pizzeria. The children followed a recipe to make their own pizza dough and then added their favourite toppings to this.

The children learnt about technology whilst using an air fryer to cook their individual pizzas.





Comparing Lengths



The children made their own snakes using paper plates. They first decorated these and then used scissors to cut along the marked lines on the plate. The children were fascinated as their painted plates became different snakes, some long and others short.



Outdoor Investigations



The children have been spending long periods of time digging in our large sandpit. They worked together collaboratively to create their own river, each taking it in turns to dig a hole and collect buckets of water.
