Our very own pirate ship

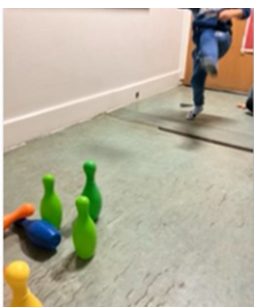
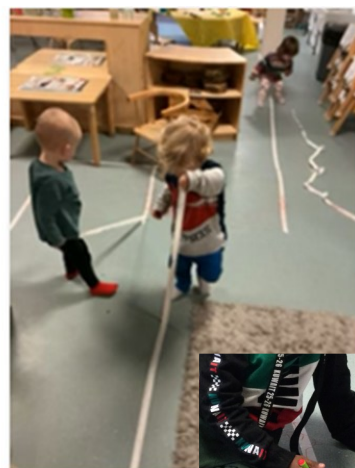
One Friday evening both Beech and Oak class children collected lots of chairs to make their very own pirate ship. We sung pirate songs together and pretended to search for treasure.
